Within the Durlston Country Park, South East tip of Purbeck, 1 mile from Swanage, Dorset.

Position 50° 35'.48 N 01° 57'.51 W (WGS 84 datum)

Safety Notice:

Restrictions to ascending the lighthouse tower staircases.

A minimum height of 1 metre is required. Under no circumstances can children or babies be carried up the stairs. Sensible footwear must be worn.

Anyone suffering from vertigo, heart disease or respiratory conditions is advised not to ascend the tower.
