1. Policy Statement

Trinity House (TH) shall be managed in a systematic, integrated, consistent and cost-effective manner within the framework of the Management System, which encourages continuous improvement and has due regard for safety, the environment and the national heritage.

TH objectives shall be established by the Executive Committee, documented within the Strategy and reviewed periodically.

To demonstrate the above, the Management System, which derives from the established business processes of TH, will be certified against the requirements of BS EN ISO 9001:2008 Quality Management Systems; BS EN ISO 14001:2004 Environmental Management Systems; BS OHSAS 18001:2007 Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems; the International Safety Management Code 2014 (ISM Code); the International Ship & Port Facility Security Code 2003 (ISPS Code) and the Maritime Labour Convention (MLC 2006).

2. Scope
