ENGINEERING AND OPERATIONS APPRENTICE (ELECTRONIC/ELECTRICAL)

JOB PURPOSE

To undertake training and development during agreed timescales to become a competent electrical and electronics technician able to undertake duties as assigned by a designated department Manager/Supervisor

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES	Field operations	 Carry out all duties assigned by the designated manager/supervisor. Successfully complete all required training courses and engage fully with any career development opportunities during apprenticeship. Assist all staff in carrying out routine inspections and servicing of the plant and equipment in accordance with published procedures. Be compliant with health and safety and other relevant legislation whilst in the workplace. Adhere to stated policies and procedures relating to health, safety, and environmental and quality management. Ownership of own personal development and maintaining competency skills. Maintain educational requirements of apprenticeship and demands of role in the workplace. Able to follow all instructions, working flexibly alongside established team members. Undertake additional tasks and responsibilities as assigned or necessary, within the scope of the role.
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS	Skills and experience	 Ability to read and understand simple electronic circuit diagrams. Able to undertake basic electrical repairs. Good IT skills. Ability to follow verbal and written instructions. Clean driving licence (desirable).

Qualifications	 Five Level 2 qualifications including English and Mathematics. A technical level 2 certificate or equivalent (e.g. City & Guilds) in an electrical or electronic engineering related discipline.
